That evening we took down our Jubilee flag and replaced it with the Union flag flown at half mast in a mark of respect. The following Sunday I had the honour of reading out the Proclamation of King Charles III on the Village Green, when the flag was raised to full mast for the reading and then back to half mast afterwards, where it stayed until after Her Majesty's funeral. It is now back at full mast.



We opened a Book of Condolence here at the Parish Office for people to come along and sign, this is still here so please feel free to come along and sign.
