Last week several Councillors went to view some outside Gym equipment which we are installing on the Alderbourne field near the play area. 'The Proludic Urbanix fitness range consists of real gym equipment that allows users to exercise all of the main core muscle groups as well as undertaking cardio-vascular workouts'. The equipment has a hydraulic system which can be set in 8 different positions and there is also an 'app' you can download that will let you track your progress.

This month we have received £4,000 from BCC Local Area Forum towards work we commissioned on preventing two bus stops from flooding. A further £7,200 has been agreed with match funding to assist us in refurbishing premises in Denham Green for our Good Neighbour Scheme. We have also been awarded £1000.00 from the 'Tesco Bags for life' fund towards this Scheme which aims to be a lifeline and a vital link in the community for those residents living on their own with no relatives nearby.
