- 1603/15. Lighting Considerations
Newtown Road – Please see Report prepared by Cllr Pamment following a consultation with residents.
- 1603/16. Light at 22 Wolstan Close, Denham
About 5/6 years ago this light was disconnected at the request of nearby residents because it shined in residents bedrooms. We have now received 2 requests to have the light switched back on. The lamp head has been vandalised and a replacement costs £295.00.
- 1603/17. Highway Considerations
Bus Stop at Denham Avenue/Village Road Junction
We have now been given authority to site the two planters to protect the bus stop users at the junction of Denham Way/Village Road. These have been ordered and should be sited before end of March
- 1603/18. Destruction of Grass Verges between Residential Properties and Esso Garage on A40.
Tfb are costing out the placement of 3 bollards and the re-instatement of the land leading to the Esso Garage, Oxford Road to prevent further vehicle access to the garage forecourt from the foot path. We have a commitment from Biffa for a contribution towards the costs and in addition the BCC Green Claims officer is pursuing additional funding from identified offenders.
